The Upstate CA Connect Consortium hereby submits its Comments in response to the CPUC Draft Resolution T-17443 Implementation of New Timelines for California Advanced Services Fund Applicants.

On behalf of the Upstate CA Connect Consortium, I submit as Comments the following:
Per the Access Sonoma Broadband (ASB) coalition, it is requested that Dry Creek, Sonoma County be added to the Appendix 4- Broadband Infrastructure Priority Areas list, as identified by the following reference information (FIPS Codes; Latitude and/Longitude Coordinates; Service Type, Public Feedback):

1. 2. Latitude: $\mathbf{3 8 . 6 6 8 6 1}$ Longitude: -122.9363109
3. Service Type (Unserved, Underserved, Served): Per Round 8 (June 2013) combined broadband availability data as shown on the CA Interactive Broadband Map, this area is deemed "served" by mobile and fixed wireless, and only partially served by fixed wireline.
4. However, recent "ground-truthing" efforts indicate otherwise. Without improved access to increased broadband infrastructure to promote economic development this entire area will not grow and prosper.

While it is understood that the inclusion of an area on "Appendix 4 - Broadband Infrastructure Priority Areas" list does not guarantee its eligibility for CASF infrastructure deployment grants or loans, so to does the exclusion of an area from this list not preclude it from eligibility.
