- 1. Mediacom already provides high-speed broadband speeds <u>in excess</u> of the State of California's required 6 Mbps download speeds and 1 Mbps upload speeds to Residential and Business Customers in much of the primary proposed/application service areas.
- Mediacom currently offers 1 Gbps download speeds and 50 Mbps upload speeds in 10 of the 21 census blocks in the proposed service areas based on the census block data Digital Path Inc. provided.
