Re: Challenge of Personal Network Computing dba Valley Internet to Certain California Advanced Services Fund Infrastructure Grant Applications

Dear Communications Division,

Personal Network Computing dba Valley Internet ("Valley Internet") hereby submits a challenge to one of the California Advanced Services Fund Infrastructure Grant Applications ("CASF Applications") submitted to the Commission on May 4, 2020.

Public Utility Code Section 281 (f) (5) (A) clearly states that projects eligible for grant awards must "[deploy] infrastructure capable of providing broadband access at speeds of a minimum of 10 megabits per second (mbps) downstream and one mbps upstream to unserved households in census blocks where no provider offers access at speeds of at least 6 mbps downstream and one mbps upstream."

Valley Internet has identified an area in the application for California Advanced Services Funding submitted by WebPerception, LLC for the Sonoma/Napa Project, that is already served by Valley Internet and receives speeds well above the minimum of 6 Mbps downstream and one Mbps upstream.

In consideration of the above, the overlap area is served and is not eligible for California Advanced Services Funding.
