ALJ DeANGELIS: Okay. Thank you. Can you tell me a little bit about the FCC process and where that stands?

MS. TAFF-RICE: Yes, your Honor. What has happened is the FCC is doing an examination as well, and they have what's called a 180-day shot clock. That has been suspended temporarily because they want to make sure that they stay in sync with the Department of Justice examination, but every piece of evidence that we have, we conferred with our colleagues on the East Coast last night, and they have told us they have every reason to believe that in fact there will be a final approval from the FCC and the DOJ in time for to us close at the end of September.

ALJ DeANGELIS: Okay. All right. I'm just going to turn to the comments filed and the motion for party status by Telnyx. And

I'm going to grant the request for party status, and I will follow up with a written ruling.

MR. GOODMAN: A small procedural question. I just wanted to out of an abundance of caution check if those notices are sufficient or if you'd like us to refile.

ALJ DeANGELIS: They're sufficient.
