Prehearing Conference Transcript Excerpt

1                   And while I completely understand  
2 all of the requirements here at the  
3 Commission and the, you know, the constraints  
4 that exist, we would just ask again  
5 respectfully if there is any way that we  
6 could try to move this forward so that the  
7 benefits that we've promised here in  
8 California have a chance to start as soon as  
9 possible

10                   ALJ DeANGELIS: Okay. Thank you. Can  
11 you tell me a little bit about the FCC  
12 process and where that stands?

13                   MS. TAFF-RICE: Yes, your Honor. What  
14 has happened is the FCC is doing an  
15 examination as well, and they have what's  
16 called a 180-day shot clock. That has been  
17 suspended temporarily because they want to  
18 make sure that they stay in sync with the  
19 Department of Justice examination, but every  
20 piece of evidence that we have, we conferred  
21 with our colleagues on the East Coast last  
22 night, and they have told us they have every  
23 reason to believe that in fact there will be  
24 a final approval from the FCC and the DOJ in  
25 time for to us close at the end of September.

26                   ALJ DeANGELIS: Okay. All right. I'm  
27 just going to turn to the comments filed and  
28 the motion for party status by Telnyx. And

1 I'm going to grant the request for party  
2 status, and I will follow up with a written  
3 ruling.

4 (Telnyx was granted Party Status.)

5 ALJ DeANGELIS: In terms of the  
6 comments, those comments will not be  
7 accepted. They're not in the proper format  
8 procedurally. They're not -- they're late.  
9 So I will follow up with a written ruling,  
10 but I wanted to let parties know that that is  
11 how I'm going to handle that pleading that  
12 came in yesterday.

13 All right. So we've talked about  
14 the scope, the schedule, motions. I'm not  
15 aware of any other additional outstanding  
16 requests that I would need to address today.

17 MR. GOODMAN: A small procedural  
18 question. Both TURN and Greenlining filed  
19 notices of intent to request intervenor  
20 compensation, sort of did that outside the  
21 normal rules because we were not sure whether  
22 the proceeding might actually resolve before  
23 there was a prehearing conference. I just  
24 wanted to out of an abundance of caution  
25 check if those notices are sufficient or if  
26 you'd like us to refile.

27 ALJ DeANGELIS: They're sufficient.

28 MR. GOODMAN: Thank you.
