MOTION OF THE UTILITY REFORM NETWORK TO SHORTEN TIME TO RESPOND TO ITS EMERGENCY MOTION TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THE CONFIDENTIAL RECORD TO THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION [PROPOSED ORDER]

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The Utility Reform Network (TURN) hereby moves, pursuant to Commission Resolution ALJ 164, and Rules 11.1 and 11.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, for an order to shorten the time to respond to TURN's Emergency Motion to Transmit a Copy of the Confidential Record to the Federal Communications Commission (Motion to Transmit Confidential Record).

Under Rule 11.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, responses to the Motion to Transmit Confidential Record would ordinarily be due fifteen (15) days after service, which places a response date on March 5, 2015. Given the CPUC's wish to inform the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in a timely fashion of the effect of the proposed merger on California, which is greater than on any other state, and the fact that sending the confidential

briefs, including all declarations and exhibits, and data request questions and responses to the FCC will not harm any party, it is reasonable to shorten the timeline to respond to TURN's Motion to Transmit Confidential Record. TURN asks that the time for that Response be shortened so that it is filed and served six days from the service of the Motion to Transmit Confidential Record, on or before close of business on Monday, February 24, 2015.

For these reasons, TURN respectfully requests that the response date to its Motion to Transmit Confidential Record for to be set at Monday, February 24, 2015.
