The Motion raises issues regarding Community Union, Inc.'s (Community Union) discovery requests.

At the hearing, CPED and Community Union shall be prepared to discuss:

1. CPED's July 23, 2020 Motion; and
2. Confidential information claims.

A court reporter will attend this hearing. To ensure a clear and clean transcript, parties must be familiar with the ground rules. Additionally, due to technical difficulties at prior hearings,

parties must prepare their technology to ensure performance and technical functionality. Parties should be visible and audible on the screen when they are called upon to speak.

Ground Rules

1. All counsel and parties agree to prepare their respective remote attendance technology and be connected at least 15 minutes prior to the time set for the hearing;
2. All counsel and parties agree to adhere to all formal rules of decorum;
3. All counsel and parties will be muted upon entering the WebEx hearing. The Judge will call upon each person directly to speak. If it is not your turn to speak, but you wish to have the opportunity to be heard, please use the hand button next to your name;
4. Only the Judge and the speaking party may be visible on the screen; and if you have not been identified by the Judge to speak, you will be muted and not be visible on the screen;
5. Identify yourself by your full name before you speak;
6. Webex recommends headphones to reduce background noise and ensure optimal sound quality; and
7. Webex suggests using Google Chrome to run its applications.
