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Pursuant to Rules 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure, Sprint Communications Company L.P. (U-5112-C), Sprint Spectrum L.P. (U-3062-C), Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. (U-4327-C) (collectively “Sprint”), and T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) (collectively, the “Joint Applicants”) hereby files this motion (“Motion to Shorten Time”) for an order to shorten the time to five days¹ to respond to Motion of Joint Applicants to Shorten the Review and Comment Periods for Proposed Decision (“Motion to Shorten PD Review and Comment Periods”), which is filed concurrently with this motion.²

¹ Under Rule 11.1(e), the Administrative Law Judge is authorized to modify the deadline for responses to written motions.

² The Joint Applicants also filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Presiding Officer’s Ruling Revising Schedule (“Motion for Reconsideration”), seeking a determination that the final decision will be voted on at the March 26, 2020 Commission meeting, as well as a motion to shorten time to respond to the Motion for Reconsideration.

In the Joint Applicants' Motion to Shorten PD Review and Comment Periods, the Joint Applicants request abbreviated public review period of 13 days, reduced from the standard 30 days, for the Commission's Proposed Decision in the current application proceedings, A.18-07-011 and A.18-07-012, as well as an abbreviated public comment period of 10 days, reduced from the standard 20 days, with no reply comments. The Commission's granting of the current motion along with their Motion to Shorten PD Review and Comment Periods would allow the Commission to make a final determination on the Proposed Decision at its March 26, 2020 business meeting.

There are only 10 days between the date of this filing and the proposed final date to issue the Proposed Decision "on or before" March 13 under the February 24, 2020 Presiding Officer's Ruling. Given this limited timeframe, a standard motion response period of 15 days is not feasible. Moreover, the Joint Applicants respectfully maintain that their stated reasons for an abbreviated Proposed Decision review and comment period are simple and straightforward, and can be addressed without lengthy, time-consuming analysis. As such, the Joint Applicants are confident that a response window of five days to the Joint Applicants' Motion to Shorten PD Review and Comment Periods is sufficient for parties to address any issues of concern arising from said motion.

For the reasons set forth herein, the Joint Applicants respectfully request a deadline of March 9, 2020 to respond to the Motion to Shorten Time.
