Briefly describe the result below and the main issues on appeal.

In the Order, the Commission addressed local regulatory barriers and streamlined the wireless infrastructure siting review process to facilitate deployment of next-generation facilities, and in particular, Small Wireless Facilities, which are smaller than traditional wireless towers. Among other things, the Order addressed "shot clocks' governing the review of wireless infrastructure deployments." Sprint now seeks relief from certain portions of the Order which violate the Administrative Procedure Act; are arbitrary, capricious, and an abuse of discretion; violate other federal laws. Specifically, the Order declines to adopt a "deemed granted" remedy when siting authorities fail to act on siting applications within the shot clock timeframes established by the Commission.

Describe any proceedings remaining below or any related proceedings in other tribunals.

This Court has consolidated other petitions for review of the FCC's September 27, 2018 order with this case, No. 19-70123. Three related cases remain pending before the United States Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit (Nos. 18-1326, 18-1294, and 18-1305). On January 11, 2019, the D.C. Circuit ordered the parties to show cause regarding transferring those cases to this Court.
